Homework in The Early Years Foundation Stage

At the beginning of each half term, class teachers in Reception set the 'Homework Passport' activities which are linked to the seven areas of learning. You should choose to complete at least two of the activities but you can choose to do more. These can be completed in your homework book or, if they are a model or a project, they can be completed separately. These pieces of homework can be handed to the teacher any time before the date given inside the booklet.

Your homework is due to be completed and returned by:

Friday 14th July 2017.

Please remember you should try to complete at least two pieces of homework, one from each subject.

Specific Areas

- Help your child to practise writing simple sentences, numbers and letters correctly.
- Let your child practise their numbers by recognising and ordering numbers 1-10 and 1-20. Continue to practise matching a numeral to the correct value.
- Talk about all the different parts of our bodies to help the children learn the correct words for different parts of their bodies. Explore the 5 senses and talk about their importance.

Prime Areas

- Talk to your child about how they feel starting a new class in September. Talk about new friends and plan small group circle times where your child can explore and talk about when they are happy, when they were excited, or when they felt lonely.
- If you have any photos you would like to send in of any holidays that you have been on we can add them to your child's special book and they can write about how they felt while they were there.
