Homework in The Early Years Foundation Stage

At the beginning of each half term, class teachers in Reception set the 'Homework Passport' activities which are linked to the seven areas of learning. You should choose to complete at least two of the activities but you can choose to do more. These can be completed in your homework book or, if they are a model or a project, they can be completed separately. These pieces of homework can be handed to the teacher any time before the date given inside the booklet.

Don't forget to read your Home/School Reading Books, and to practise your Letter and Number Formations.

You can also practise writing your name.

Specific Areas

- Help your child to practise writing their name, numbers, letters and simple CVC words correctly for example: cat, ran, bug, tin.
- Practise numbers by recognising and ordering the numbers 1-50. Continue to practise matching a numeral to the correct value.
- Identify 2D and 3D shapes and talk about their properties.
- Read traditional stories and talk about the themes for example characters, beginning, middle and end.
- Read with your child daily.

Prime Areas

- At home you can read a range of traditional tales with your child and talk about the morals of the stories, for example the discourteous nature of the characters in 'The Little Red Hen' and 'Goldilocks and the 3 Bears'
- Teach your child to eat using a knife and fork and discuss healthy foods so that children become aware of healthy food choices.
- Practice skills which develop fine motor skills for example cutting, handwriting, threading etc.
