4. Choose a noun. How many adjectives can you think of to describe the noun?

5. Choose a verb. How many adverbs can you think of to describe the verb?
E.g. walk – slowly, quickly.

1. Revise counting up in 2, 5, and 10s. Can you count down from 100 in 2, 5 and 10s?
2. Play shop using real money. What will they buy? How many things will they buy? How much change will they get? Write down your number sentences.
