1. Choose a habitat. Research which animals live there and create a food chain to show how they interact.
2. Explain how where you live is similar and different to another place in the world. Where would you rather live? Why?
3. Use the internet to find out about Neil Armstrong and the famous Apollo 11 launch to the moon from Florida in 1969.
4. Imagine you are David Attenborough and you have just discovered a new species of animal. Make a model of this animal.

English:

Choose 2 or more to complete:

1. Write a list of questions you could ask the Author, Simon Bartram. Remember to include capital letters and question marks.
2. Write your favourite traditional tale. Remember to use nouns, adjectives, adverbs, punctuation marks and conjunctions.
3. Write a diary for one week. Use the past tense in your sentences.

Eg: I went to the shop and I bought a lollipop.

Include lots of verbs and some adverbs.

4. Write a review of a book or film that you have enjoyed. Give reasons why you liked it and try to suggest who you think would be interested in it.
5. Use the internet to research information about David Attenborough. Choose your own method to present the information.

Maths:

As we are preparing for our Maths Tests in May it is important that you continue to practise the following at home:

1. 2, 5 and 10 times tables
2. Counting money and working out change from a larger amount of money.
3. Practising number bonds to 10, 20 and 100, for example: $4+6=10$, $5+5=10$ and $6+4=10$.
4. Reading the time and calculating the time an hour ahead or before a given time.
5. Finding fractions of shapes and quantities e.g. $\frac{3}{4}$ of 16; $\frac{2}{3}$ of 18.
6. Inverse operations: $\square + 18 = 27$;
 $\square - 15 = 25$
