5. Research the importance of exercise and why it is important for humans to exercise. Draw or use pictures from the computer or magazines to illustrate different exercises.
6. Make a model to show how a joint works to allow our bones to move.

3. Write a newspaper report about the 'Killer Cat', include a headline, photo and caption.
4. Write 10 sentences using verbs and adverbs. Remember a verb is a doing or action word and an adverb describes a verb. E.g. He walked slowly to school.
5. Write a paragraph to persuade someone that The Devonshire Hill Nursery and Primary School is the best school in the world!

### Maths

**Choose at least two pieces to complete:**

1. Create a timetable of what you did on a Saturday. Include the time for each activity. Which activity did you spend most of your time doing?  
E.g. 9:15am - Helped mum with the washing up. Draw pictures to make it even more interesting.
2. Practice counting on in 2s, 3s, 4s, 5s and 10s. Then try some multiplication and division problems.
