Choose 2 or more to complete:

1. Pretend you are a prehistoric man/woman. Write your diary entry on a typical day: What you do daily, where you live, how you stay warm, what food do you eat and how you prepare it.
2. Create an information booklet about the Iron Age, Stone Age or Bronze Age.
3. During the Stone Age, people lived in caves. If you were to live in a cave what would you like it to look like and what would be in it? Use your imagination and be creative.
4. Cave paintings were used to tell stories. Make up your own story using cave art painting and pictures.
5. Write the journey of a stone. Starting at the stone's origin at the mountain top, describe its journey down to the river and then into the sea. This should be written as a story where eventually you pick up the stone and it ends up in your pocket.

Choose 2 or more to complete:

1. Create a time line through the ages.
2. Write out and learn:
number bonds to 20 and 100;
doubles 11 - 20, 30, 40 and 50;
halves of 20, 30, 40, 50, 60, 70, 80, 90 and 100

3. Find a variety of fruit and vegetables. Estimate how much they weigh then weigh them accurately. Put the items in order of mass.
