4. How many days old are you?
5. Investigate these four statements:
  - The sum of 3 odd numbers is odd.
  - Half way between any 2 multiples of 10 is a multiple of 5
  - Multiples of 4 end in 0,2,4,6, or 8.
  - Any odd number is double a number add 1
