### Maths:

Choose 2 or more to complete:

1. Measure the area of your bedroom. If carpet costs £5.25 per square metre, what is the cost of 8 square metres of carpet? If 4 rooms in your house are a similar in size to your bedroom. What is the cost of carpet needed to cover all 5 rooms?
2. Measure ten different objects from around your home using a ruler, use cm and mm. You will need to represent each measurement as a decimal, as a fraction and also pictorially.
3. Research the different Roman numerals and record their values? Generate some Roman numeral addition, subtraction, multiplication and division problems, can you solve them?
4. Practise doubling and halving 2 and 3 digit numbers.

1. Paint or draw a picture of your local area – think about the colours you could use and the different details you could add to your picture.
