Choose 2 or more to complete:

1. Design two book marks. The first should have a symmetrical pattern. The second should have a shape including acute and obtuse angles.

3. Create a game where you have to match fractions to their decimal equivalents.
4. Choose ten objects around your house. Use a suitable measuring tool. Record the lengths in mm, cm and m.
5. Make a game to learn the times tables .e.g. 'Fortune Teller'.

English:

Choose 2 or more to complete:

1. Imagine that you are a piece of food, write about your journey through the human body starting from the moment you enter the mouth.
2. Create a picture. Write the instructions for someone to follow to draw the picture.
3. Write a story entitled 'A day in the life of a carrot'.
4. Research the author 'Valerie Bloom'. Present the information in your own way.
5. Write a poem about 'Healthy Eating'. Include different fruits and vegetables that you like to eat. Use interesting adjectives to describe them.
6. Design a nutritional meal for our school chef to create.
