

Breakfast Club	Charge at a rate of £2.50 per session. Application form Appendix B
School Meal	Charged at a daily rate of £2.50 per meal.
Residential Visits	If the school organises a residential visit in school time, or mainly in school time, which is to provide education directly related to the National Curriculum, we do not make any charge for the education element. However, parents are obliged to at least pay for the residential expenses of such trips, and we also ask parents to contribute to the full cost of the travel and activity expenses as these are beyond the scope of our main school budget. A savings scheme will operate to allow parents to spread the cost of such trips over a longer period of time.
After School Clubs	Parents are required to meet the full cost. If the income for each activity does not meet the overall cost, such activities may have to be cancelled. Where external providers provide activities, the school will agree a Service Level Agreement in accordance with the approved Extended Services Policy.
Late Arrival and Collection of Children	<p>The Governing Body have agreed that the School can levy a late pick up charge to parents who persistently (3 occasions) arrive late to collect their child/ren from school, including nursery.</p> <p>The Charges are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- £10 (3:30pm to 3:45pm; 12pm for AM session for nursery children)- £20 per every half hour thereafter.
Swimming Classes	Swimming Tuition for year 3 children is met from the School Budget.
Individual Instrumental Music Tuition	Whole Class Instrument Tuition for Year 4 children is not charged to parents; the costs are met from the School Budget. The Music & Performing Arts Service Level Agreement also includes provision for up to 12 Year 5 children continuing with their instrument. The school has the option to buy in additional tuition at £30 per hour and additional instrument hire if demand is higher.
School Uniform	The charges for items of uniform sold by the School are based on a non- commercial rate in order to cover costs. On occasion, the School will sell second-hand items of uniform at a reduced cost. A full list of costs is available from the school reception.
Ingredients/Materials for practical subjects in Nursery and Reception	Parents are encouraged to contribute 50p per week to help provide materials for practical subjects.
Lost School equipment, books, etc.	Parents may be requested to replace school equipment, books, etc. which have been lost by their child.
Breakages and damages to school buildings, furniture or property.	Wilful damage to school buildings or property by a pupil may be charged to parents by the school.

Lettings
