

Examples of where a child at this school has been issued with a fixed term exclusion for a serious breach of the School's Pupil Behaviour & Discipline Policy.

Breach of the school policy 2014/15	Number of days issued
Physical Assault against an Adult (PA) Verbal Abuse /threatening behaviour against an adult. (VA)	3 Days
Physical Assault against a pupil (PP)	5 Days
Physical Assault against an Adult (PA) Physical Assault against a Pupil (PP) Verbal Abuse /threatening behaviour against an Adult (VA) Verbal Abuse /threatening behaviour against a Pupil (VP)	2 Days
Physical Assault against an adult (PA)	2 Days
Verbal Abuse/Threatening Behaviour against a pupil (VP) Persistent Disruptive Behaviour (DB)	3 Days
Physical Assault against a Pupil. (PP)	3 Days
Physical Assault against an Adult (PA) Persistent Disruptive Behaviour (DB) Other (OT) Destroying school property	5 Days

*A punishment must be proportionate. In determining whether a punishment is reasonable, section 91 of the Education and Inspections Act 2006 says the penalty must be reasonable in all the circumstances and that account must be taken of the pupil's age, any special educational needs or disability they may have, and any religious requirements affecting them. **DFE Behaviour and discipline in school.
