Calligraphy is the art of forming beautiful symbols by hand and arranging them well. It's a set of skills and techniques for positioning and inscribing words so they show integrity, harmony, some sort of ancestry and rhythm.

Origami is the art of folding paper which involves the creation of paper forms usually entirely by folding. Animals, birds, fish, geometric shapes, puppets, toys and masks are among the models that even very young children can learn to make in just one sitting.

Kung Fu Fan is a dynamic and enjoyable fan form that incorporates wide range of movements from traditional Chinese Kungfu and Tai Chi as well as movements from non-martial sources. Coupled with the distinctively motivating, energising music.
