Focus Text: 'The Tiny Seed' by Eric Carle

Choose 1 or more to complete:

1. Make a model of an insect or plant.
2. Research the life cycle of a creature, some suggestions might be a butterfly, a frog or a snake. Draw a diagram of its life cycle and don't forget to include labels.
3. Create a mini-beast model using recycled objects.
4. Design your very own bug costume.
5. Draw a plant or flower. Using a pencil, sketch the plant in detail. Use colours or paints to complete the detail on your plant.
6. Research an artist who paints/sculpts/draws flowers. Create your own artwork, choose your own media you could use paint, colouring pencils, etc.

Books and record this in your **Reading Diary**.

You should practice your **Weekly Spelling Words** in time for your test and learn your **Times Tables**.
