Home Learning Passport

Home Learning Passports are given at the start of each term. This passport contains a selection of activities for you to complete at home. These activities support **English** and **Topic** learning from the curriculum in class.

You should complete:

- At least **three** activities for **English**
- At least **one** activity for **Topic**
- All written work must be completed neatly in your **Yellow Writing Home Learning Book**
- Models and other creative pieces of work are to be completed and presented separately. This work must be handed to your class teacher any time before or on the date given in this passport.

Home Learning for **Mathematics** and **Spelling** will be given every **Friday**:

Maths work should be completed neatly in your **Blue Maths Home Learning Book** and returned for marking by Wednesday of the following week.

Spelling words should be practised in your **Spelling Home Learning Book** and will be tested the following Friday.

Focus Text - *Tales of Wisdom & Wonder*
by Hugh Lupton

These activities must be completed in your yellow Writing Home Learning Book. This book is checked by your teacher every Wednesday.

1. Pretend you are a prehistoric man/woman. Write your diary entry on a typical day: What you do daily, where you live, how you stay warm, what food do you eat and how you prepare it.
2. Create an information booklet about the Iron Age, Stone Age or Bronze Age.
3. Write the journey of a stone. Starting at the stone's origin at the mountain top, describe its journey down to the river and then into the sea. This should be written as a story where eventually you pick up the stone and it ends up in your pocket.
4. Compare your life today to the life of a prehistoric person. What are the similarities and differences?

Don't forget to read your Home/School Reading Books and record this in your Reading Diary. You should practice your Weekly Spelling Words in time for your test and learn your Times Tables.
