- Models and other creative pieces of work are to be completed and presented separately

This work must be handed to your class teacher any time before or on the date given in this passport.

Home Learning for **Mathematics** and **Spelling** will be given every **Friday**, and will reflect the learning objectives from current lessons. - Write a diary entry entitled 'A Day in the Life of a Vicious Viking'
- Write a prediction about how the story of 'The London Eye Mystery' will develop. What do you think will happen?
