You should complete:

- At least **three activities for Topic**
- All written work must be completed neatly in your **Yellow 'Home Writing Book'**
- Models and other creative pieces of work are to be completed and presented separately

This work must be handed to your class teacher any time before or on the date given in this passport.

Home Learning for **Mathematics** and **Spelling** will be given every **Friday**, and will reflect the learning objectives from current lessons. This work should be completed neatly in your **Blue 'Home Maths Book'** and returned for marking by Wednesday of the following week. Spelling words will be tested the following Friday.

Choose 3 or more to complete:

- Create a 3D collage/ picture using a selection of different recycled materials.
- Choose a room in your house and make a list of the things that you see, what materials are they made of? e.g. table-wood, water bottle - plastic, window - glass, pillow - fabric.
- Make a collection of different items in your home that are made from the same material? This can be presented either by photographs, cutting and sticking pictures of the objects or alternatively drawing the objects.
- Research different materials and write an information book about them.

*Don't forget to read your **Home/School Reading Books** and record this in your **Reading Record**. You should practice your **Weekly Spelling Words** in time for your test and learn your **Times Tables**.*

*Please remember you should try to complete at least **three pieces of homework**, from each subject.*

English

Focus Texts: 'The Tiger Who Came to Tea' by J Kerr
'Peace at Last' by J Murphy
'Lost and Found' by Oliver Jeffers

These activities must be completed in your yellow 'Home Writing Book'. This book is checked by your teacher every Wednesday.

Choose 3 or more to complete:

- Write a recount of your weekend. Remember to write in first person and in the past tense. Example: 'I went to my aunt's house and played in her garden.'
- Make a poster to teach your friends how to write an interesting sentence. Remind them about capital letters, full stops, adjectives, adverbs and finger spaces.
- Write some 'wow' words to describe the fireworks.
- Create 3D models of food for the tiger's tea party.
- Write a description of what it is like in your house at night. What does it look like? What does it sound like? What does it feel like?
