Home Learning Passports are given at the start of each new term. This passport contains a selection of activities for you to complete at home. These activities support **English** and **Topic** learning from the curriculum covered during the current term.

You should complete:

- At least **three** activities for **English**
- At least **three** activities for **Topic**
- All written work must be completed neatly in your **Yellow 'Home Writing Book'**
- Models and other creative pieces of work are to be completed and presented separately

This work must be handed to your class teacher any time before or on the date given in this passport.

Home Learning for **Mathematics** and **Spelling** will be given every **Friday**, and will reflect the learning objectives from current lessons. This work should be completed neatly in your **Blue 'Home Maths Book'** and returned for marking by Wednesday of the following week. Spelling words will be tested the following Friday.

Topic: 'Land, Sky and Sea'

Choose 3 or more to complete:

- Draw and label a Food Chain.
- Make a 3D model of an animal habitat (rainforest, ocean, cave, pond etc.)
- Collect photographs of different animals in their habitats. Display the photographs in a collage.
- Make a model or draw a flower and label the parts. Can you describe the process of photosynthesis in plants?
- Create a new animal or creature who will represent and protect the Devonshire Hill Forest. What will they look like? What will we call them? Draw a picture or make a model. What will they tell people about the importance of trees?

English

Focus Text: These activities must be completed in your yellow 'Home Writing Book'. This book is checked by your teacher every Wednesday. **Choose 3 or more to complete:**

- Choose either a salt water or fresh water habitat and research the animals that live there.
- Use the following words to create a Word Search: Wilbur, Charlotte, spider, barnyard, runt, magnum opus, Fern, county fair, some pig, radiant, humble, web, and Templeton.
- Create a poster to advertise an 'Animal Fair'.
- Write a diary entry detailing a day in the life of a pig or a spider.
- Write a report about an animal you have learnt about or that you are interested in.
- Make a poster about why we should protect natural habitats.
