You should complete:

- At least **three activities for English**
- At least **three activities for Topic**
- All written work must be completed neatly in your **Yellow 'Home Writing Book'**
- Models and other creative pieces of work are to be completed and presented separately

This work must be handed to your class teacher any time before or on the date given in this passport.

Home Learning for **Mathematics** and **Spelling** will be given every **Friday**, and will reflect the learning objectives from current lessons. This work should be completed neatly in your **Blue 'Home Maths Book'** and returned for marking by Wednesday of the following week. Spelling words will be tested the following Friday.

Choose 3 or more to complete:

- Make a 3D model toy from recycled materials. Try to include a moving part.
- Design a toy that could be from the future. Draw and label a picture of your idea and give a brief description of what the toy does.
- Sort your toys into groups, for example: soft toys, electronic toys, wooden toys, mechanical toys. Label the groups and then take pictures to bring to school or make a collage with the pictures.
- Research different toys using the computer and write an information book about them.

*Don't forget to read your **Home/School Reading Books** and record this in your **Reading Record**. You should practice your **Weekly Spelling Words** in time for your test and learn your **Times Tables**.*

*Please remember you should try to complete at least **three pieces of homework, from each subject.***

- Write a recount of your weekend. Remember to write in first person and in the past tense. Example: 'I went to my aunt's house and played in her garden.'
- Make a poster to teach your friends how to write an interesting sentence. Remind them about capital letters, full stops, adjectives, adverbs and finger spaces.
- Write some 'wow' words to describe your favourite toy.
- Design and create a 3D model of a new and exciting toy. Don't forget to label your drawing.
- Write a description of what it is like in your house at night. What does it look like? What does it sound like? What does it feel like?
