You should complete:

- At least three activities for English
- At least three activities for Topic
- All written work must be completed neatly in your Yellow 'Home Writing Book'
- Models and other creative pieces of work are to be completed and presented separately

This work must be handed to your class teacher any time before or on the date given in this passport.

Home Learning for Mathematics and Spelling will be given every Friday, and will reflect the learning objectives from current lessons. This work should be completed neatly in your Blue 'Home Maths Book' and returned for marking by Wednesday of the following week.

Spelling words will be tested the following Friday.

On the final week of each half term pupils will showcase their achievements in a special Home Learning focused Celebration Assembly.

English

Focus Texts: 'Traction Man is Here' - by Mini Grey
'The Elephant and the Bad Baby'

'Dogger' - by Shirley Hughes

These activities must be completed in your yellow 'Home Writing Book'. This book is checked by your teacher every Wednesday. **Choose 3 or more to complete:**

- Research the journey of a plastic bottle. What happens to the plastic bottle from the moment it is made at the factory, to the moment that you place it in the recycling? Write a timeline which includes each step you should illustrate this.
- Write a story about a magical land where everything is made out of an unusual material for example, jelly, paper or wool. Remember to use interesting adjectives.
- Traction Man is going on holiday. What will he pack in his suitcase? Write a list of at least ten items of clothing that traction man will take in his suitcase. Describe each item carefully and don't forget to tell us where he is going.
- Design a poster which will encourage people to read one of the Year 2 Focus Texts. Include a short blurb which will tell people what the book is about.

Don't forget to read your Home/School Reading Books and record this in your Reading Record. You should practice your Weekly Spelling Words in time for your test and learn your Times Tables.
