## Home Learning Passport

Home Learning Passports are given at the start of each new term. This passport contains a selection of activities for you to complete at home. These activities support English and Topic learning from the curriculum covered during the current term.

*You should complete:*

- At least three activities for English
- At least three activities for Topic
- All written work must be completed neatly in your Yellow 'Home Writing Book'
- Models and other creative pieces of work are to be completed and presented separately

*This work must be handed to your class teacher any time before or on the date given in this passport.*

Home Learning for Mathematics and Spelling will be given every Friday, and will reflect the learning objectives from current lessons. This work should be completed neatly in your Blue 'Home Maths Book' and returned for marking by Wednesday of the following week. Spelling words will be tested the following Friday.

### English

**Focus Text:** 'Tales of Wisdom & Wonder'  
- by Hugh Lupton.

These activities must be completed in your yellow 'Home Writing Book'. This book is checked by your teacher every Wednesday. **Choose 3 or more to complete:**

- Pretend you are a prehistoric man/woman. Write your diary entry on a typical day: What you do daily, where you live, how you stay warm, what food do you eat and how you prepare it.
- Create an information booklet about the Iron Age, Stone Age or Bronze Age.
- Write the journey of a stone. Starting at the stone's origin at the mountain top, describe its journey down to the river and then into the sea. This should be written as a story where eventually you pick up the stone and it ends up in your pocket.
- Compare your life today to the life of a prehistoric person. What are the similarities and differences?
- Write a book review about the Year 4 Focus Text. Include the book's title, the Author's name, some writing about your favourite part of the book and an illustration of a scene from the book.

Don't forget to read your **Home/School Reading Books**, practice your **Weekly Spelling Words** in time for your test and practise your **Times Tables** using **T T Rockstars**.
