Warmer weather advice

In the coming weeks of warmer weather we advise the following:



- For children to stay hydrated please provide your child with a reusable bottle containing WATER ONLY and NO ICE. This should be taken home and refilled daily.
- Sun cream should be applied before attending school and sunhats are advisable. School sunhats are available from mapac.com
- Suitable adjustments can be made to school uniform, for example tights can be swapped for socks, skirts and trousers for yellow chequered summer dresses or grey tailored shorts. Uniform should remain smart and presentable in the correct school colours with black shoes, children are not allowed to wear sandals to school.
- Pupils must bring their PE kit to school - wearing school uniform to participate in sports is unsuitable and unhygienic.
- Keep fresh - keep washed - smell clean!
