Home Learning Passports are given at the start of each new term. This passport contains a selection of activities for you to complete at home. These activities support English and Topic learning from the curriculum covered during the current term.

You should complete:

- At least three activities for English
- At least three activities for Topic
- All written work must be completed neatly in your Yellow 'Home Writing Book'
- Models and other creative pieces of work are to be completed and presented separately

This work must be handed to your class teacher any time before or on the date given in this passport.

Home Learning for Mathematics and Spelling will be given every Friday, and will reflect the learning objectives from current lessons. This work should be completed neatly in your Blue 'Home Maths Book' and returned for marking by Wednesday of the following week.

Spelling words will be tested the following Friday.

On the final week of each half term pupils will showcase their achievements in a special Home Learning focused Celebration Assembly.

English

These activities must be completed in your yellow 'Home Writing Book'. This book is checked by your teacher every Wednesday. **Choose 3 or more to complete:**

- Keep a diary for a week. Write about any fun things you do, remember to write in sentences using a capital letter and a full stop. You can draw some pictures to illustrate.
- Imagine you have been given a wild animal as a pet. Write about how you would look after it.
- Write instructions on how to make your favourite sandwich. Remember to use - first, next, then, and finally.
- Describe 2 characters in your focus text e.g. The Queen, Emily or Stanley. You can illustrate them too!
- Write a book review or design a poster to encourage people to read either of the focus texts or a non fiction book which is relevant to your Topic.

Don't forget to read your Home/School Reading Books and record this in your Reading Record. You should practice your Weekly Spelling Words in time for your test and learn your Times Tables.
