Home Learning Passport

Home Learning Passports are given at the start of each new term. This passport contains a selection of activities for you to complete at home. These activities support English and Topic learning from the curriculum covered during the current term.

You should complete:

- At least three activities for English
- At least three activities for Topic
- All written work must be completed neatly in your Yellow 'Home Writing Book'
- Models and other creative pieces of work are to be completed and presented separately

This work must be handed to your class teacher any time before or on the date given in this passport.

Home Learning for Mathematics and Spelling will be given every Friday, and will reflect the learning objectives from current lessons. This work should be completed neatly in your Blue 'Home Maths Book' and returned for marking by Wednesday of the following week. Spelling words will be tested the following Friday.

English

Focus Text: 'The Miraculous Journey of Edward Tulane' by Katie Di Camillo

These activities must be completed in your yellow 'Home Writing Book'. This book is checked by your teacher every Wednesday.

Choose 3 or more to complete:

- Imagine that you witnessed an earthquake or a hurricane, write an imaginative witness report.
- Write an adventure story. You are on holiday when a tsunami sweeps you off of your feet and washes you somewhere else. Where does it take you? What happens next?
- Write a poem to describe what happens during a natural disaster. Include similes, alliterations and powerful adjectives.
- Design a poster or leaflet to inform people how to be safe during an earthquake.
- Write a book review or design a poster to encourage people to read year 3's focus text. Remember to include your own descriptive blurb.

Don't forget to read your **Home/School Reading Books**, practice your **Weekly Spelling Words** in time for your test and practise your **Times Tables** using **T T Rockstars**.

Choose 3 or more to complete:

- Design and create a poster of our active planet, use pictures and/or clippings from newspapers and the internet.
- Make a 3D volcano. Could you investigate how to actually make it erupt? Film the eruption to share with your class.
- Create a fact file about a famous volcano, remember to include a labelled illustration of the volcano.
- Create a 3D model showing the layers of earth.
- Research a recent earthquake, write a report to show the key facts about it.
- Draw a map of the world and add a symbol to show where there are volcanoes.
