## Home Learning Passport

Home Learning Passports are given at the start of each new term. This passport contains a selection of activities for you to complete at home. These activities support English and Topic learning from the curriculum covered during the current term.

*You should complete:*

- At least three activities for English
- At least three activities for Topic
- All written work must be completed neatly in your Yellow 'Home Writing Book'
- Models and other creative pieces of work are to be completed and presented separately

*This work must be handed to your class teacher any time before or on the date given in this passport.*

Home Learning for Mathematics and Spelling will be given every Friday, and will reflect the learning objectives from current lessons. This work should be completed neatly in your Blue 'Home Maths Book' and returned for marking by Wednesday of the following week. Spelling words will be tested the following Friday.

### English

These activities must be completed in your yellow 'Home Writing Book'. This book is checked by your teacher every Wednesday. **Choose 3 or more to complete:**

- Write a news article which informs people of the importance of our rainforests. You should include information such as where the rainforests are, why they need protecting and how people can help to protect the rainforest. Illustrate your news article.
- Choose one rainforest and write an information booklet about it, remember to make it clear which part of the world this rainforest is in.
- What problems do rainforests face? Create a persuasive poster or leaflet to help save them.
- Make a set of 'Did You Know?' fact cards to teach others about the rainforests.
- Write an adventure story set in a rainforest.

**Choose 3 or more to complete.**

- Create a collage picture of a rainforest.
- Create a diorama model of a rainforest.
- Paint/draw a rainforest scene showing the layers and animals that are found there.
- Make 3D models of rainforest animals.
- Create a board game to test each other's knowledge of key facts about rainforests.
- Use your knowledge of the rainforest to create your own imaginary creature who would live in the rainforest.
- Design a poster which teaches people about the importance of the rainforests. Why are they important and why we should look after them. What can people do in order to help protect our rainforests?
