Science: Micro-Habitats

Create a poster or a 3-D model. Name plants and animals found in micro-habitats such as in the pond, under a log, in a bush or in the soil.



Maths: Measuring Lengths

Measure different objects around your house and create a list of their lengths in centimetres. You can include things like your favourite book, a cereal box, a stuffed animal, or even your own hand! Create a poster with your objects and their measurements.



Geography: The United Kingdom

Create a UK map. Label each country with its name, show the capital cities, add famous landmarks in each of the four countries (e.g., Big Ben in London, Edinburgh Castle in Scotland, Cardiff Castle in Wales, Giant's Causeway in Northern Ireland).
