### Celebration Assembly - weekly | [parents/carers invited](#) - 9.05am

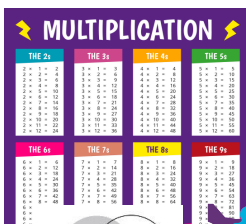

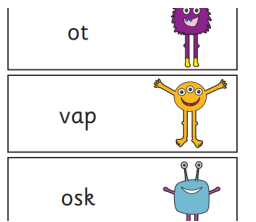
**Stay & Read Sessions** | Every Friday | Nursery parents/carers invited
