Home Learning

Dear Parent/Carer

We are launching our new Home Learning Policy today. This has been updated in response to parent surveys, teacher consultation, Ofsted best practice guidance and our commitment to provide high quality learning experiences that you can complete at home with your children.

Attached is a flyer explaining the expectations and the timetable. All children will need to have a school book bag so that they can bring their Home Learning to and from school daily as best practice and as a minimum on **every** Wednesday and Friday without fail. All children from Years 1-5 will be provided with 4 books:

- Mathematics Home Learning Book
- English/Topic Home Learning Book
- Spelling Home Learning Book
- Reading Record Book

Many of the children have already been issued with the Home Reading Record. When your child has filled/completed their book they will be issued with another book. Parents will need to ensure all books are looked after as lost books will not be replaced by the school but are available for purchase via the school office.

As parents you have a responsibility to support your child to complete all home learning on time and to bring it to school on the required days; Wednesdays and Fridays.

Year 6 have an individual Home Learning Schedule in addition to the requirements of the Home Learning Policy and they will be directed by their classteachers. We expect all Year 6 pupils to be spending an increased amount of time practising and revising for their forthcoming exams in May. This is also in preparation for their transition to secondary school whereby they will be required to manage their home learning timetable independently.

Children in Nursery and Reception will receive the Home Learning Passport whereby parents are encouraged to support the activities at home with their child. In addition to this children will be given a Home Reading Record and will be placed onto the Home Reading Scheme under the direction of their classteacher as and when they are ready to do so. All children in Nursery & Reception should have a Home Reading Bag and they will be encouraged to take home a book of their choice for you to read and share with them at home. The teacher will also supply additional resources to support the activities in the Homework Passports. If you require advice re Home Learning for children in Nursery and Reception, then please make an appointment to see your child's classteacher.

It will take a few weeks to embed the new systems and we appreciate your support during this transitional time.

Every child must bring this bag and its contents to school every Wednesday & Friday

Blue Spelling Home Learning Book:

- Spellings set every Friday by the class teacher
- Children are tested the following Friday

Blue Mathematics Home Learning Book:

- Mathematics work set every Friday by teacher
- Marked every Wednesday

Yellow Writing Home Learning Book:

- Set via the Home Learning Passport
- Progress checked every Wednesday by the teacher
- Complete 3 pieces of English writing
- All completed by the date set in the Passport

Models /Creative Art:

- Set by the Home Learning Passport
- Complete at least 1 piece of Topic work
- Presented to your teacher any time up until the date set in the Passport



Home Reading Record

- New Home Reading Book sent home every Friday
- An adult must sign the reading record weekly
