Purchase of Kandu Playground Markings	£2627.00	Noticeable increase in physical activity for KS1 pupils in KS1 playground. Pupils engaging with the markings on a daily basis. The markings are a permanent feature in the playground, allowing pupils to benefit for years to come.
Purchase of 3 x Permanent Football Goals Grass Marking Machine	£ 1905.00 £ 288.00	KS2 pupils use the marked pitches, complete with permanent goals, every day during lunch break, further increasing participation in football across the school. Additionally, the marked pitches have allowed the school to host several inter-school friendlies and competitions at the school. These competitions have been extremely popular, involving both boys and girls teams from Key Stages 1&2.

		The permanence of the posts means that decades of pupils attending the school will benefit from their installation.
Haringey Sports – Competition Affiliation	£120.00	Our affiliation has allowed us to continue to participate in local competitions, allowing our most talented pupils to experience competitive borough-wide sport.
Purchase of Cricket Equipment	£414.80	<p>The purchase of this equipment has allowed an after-school cricket club for KS2 to run with much more success. Several pupils, completely new to the sport, attended sessions and both a girls and mixed team represented the school in the Haringey Kwik Cricket tournament in the summer of 2015.</p> <p>Update: In 2016, the school cricket team won their group-stage tournament at the Haringey Indoor Cricket Competition, making into the Haringey Finals.</p>
Purchase Basketball Posts for Main Hall	£321.95	<p>The purchase of these basketball posts (for indoor use) was in conjunction with the establishment of a brand-new after-school basketball club for KS1.</p> <p>In addition, the posts are regularly used for lunch-time clubs, run by the Pastoral Care Team.</p>
British Heart Foundation ‘Skipathon’	£327.50	<p>The purchase of skipping ropes for the skipathon allowed us to run a successful BHF ‘skipathon’ in March of 2015. The day was a fantastic way to get all of our pupils from Years 1 – 6 active and raise awareness of healthy and active lifestyles.</p> <p>Additionally, the skipping equipment is used daily in the KS2 playground, increasing physical activity for a number of our pupils.</p>
Join Haringey CPD Package	£1350.00	<p>Joining this CPD package has allowed us to send several members of staff on relevant and engaging CPD. To date, we have sent members of staff on dance, gymnastics, change4life and invasion games CPD. In addition, our school leader for PE and sport regularly attends the PE coordinator modules.</p> <p>The opportunity for staff members to develop their subject knowledge and confidence allows them to deliver higher quality, engaging PE lessons alongside our PE specialist. Staff CPD A-Life	£150.00	A-Life's session (on simple games and tips for invasion games) has given staff a range of useful ideas to use in sessions. This has led to an increase in confidence when leading PE sessions and, for some, after-school clubs.

		Staff members are better placed to lead lessons that increase pupil activity, helping our pupils to enjoy a more active school experience.
Run an Inter-School Football Competition Football Pitch Markings Tournament Banner Trophy, Ribbons and Medals	£475.00 £27.20 £133.61	Our more able footballers were able to experience competitive football as well as the opportunity to host a tournament. Pupils who were not participating were able to support, raising the profile of school sport and competition.
Run Sports Days for KS1 & 2	£2160.00	We employed coaches from ELMs to run our sports days in Key Stages 1 & 2. The days were extremely successful, allowing all of our pupils to engage in competition and earn points for their house. Running days like this engages pupils in competitive sport and gives them invaluable sporting experiences and memories which will help to inspire and engage them in PE and Sport throughout their school lives and beyond.
Provide Spare PE Kits	£355.20	Purchasing extra school PE kits for each classroom has enabled pupils who arrive at school without their PE kit to participate fully in sessions. The impact of this has been increased participation in all PE sessions and an increase in pupils bringing in their own kit. This step has also shown pupils that PE sessions are a vital part of the curriculum that should not be missed.
Set-Up Termly House Competitions House Shield	£46.00	The introduction of a House Shield (awarded to the winning house each term) as part of termly house competition has led to ALL pupils have an opportunity, at least once a term, to participate in competitive sport. Competition for the shield is fierce and there has been a noticeable improvement in pupil dedication and commitment in PE sessions as a result. Additionally, the house competition is helping to raise the profile of the subject across the school.

Haringey Sports – Competition Affiliation	£118.00	Our affiliation has allowed us to continue to participate in local competitions, allowing our most talented pupils to experience competitive borough-wide sport.
Improvement of KS2 Playground Basketball Posts and Balls Table Tennis Tables Kingball Markings	£355.95 £2109.95	After conducting a survey into pupil participation in lunch and break-time activities, we have upgraded the provision available in our KS2 playground. Pupils regularly participate in games of Kingball, basketball and, more recently, table tennis. All of these new features are permanent structures aimed at providing a sustainable increase in sporting opportunities for our pupils during their free time.
Purchase Football Kits for Boys and Girls Teams	£492.45 £76.50	Pupils are proud to represent their school in their brand new kit. This has added to the importance of representing the school in football matches.
Introduce 'Lean Fifteen'	£19.08 £7.86	Pupils across Years 1-6 are now engaged in (at least) 15 minutes of extra physical activity each week. Pupils take part in a carousel of 5 activities for three minutes each (running, throwing / catching, tennis, skipping and agility ladders) and they are becoming increasingly aware of the health benefits of increased physical activity. Introducing 'Lean Fifteen' in curriculum time has also raised the profile of PE and Sport for both pupils and teachers.
