The science of sound

In science we are learning about sound. We'll find out how sounds are made and how our ears work. Design and make a musical instrument that has an interesting sound. Write a short explanation of how you made it and explain how sounds reach our ears.

Viewpoints and dreams

Our art topic is 'Viewpoints and Dreams'. We will be looking at the work of surrealist artists such as Salvador Dali. Make a piece of art work inspired by a dream. Or, you could create a dreamlike, mystical landscape. Make sure that you use all of your creative talents by incorporating lots of colours and textures!

Rainbow Dragons

During our Talk for Writing lessons we will be writing our own information texts about the imaginary 'Rainbow Dragon'. Create your own Rainbow Dragon model and write a short information booklet to go with it. Or design an information poster to teach people about the diet, habitats and appearance of Rainbow Dragons.
