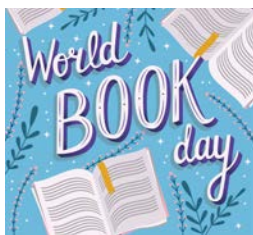


Flatford Mill residential trip - selected Y6 children | 8.30am arrival

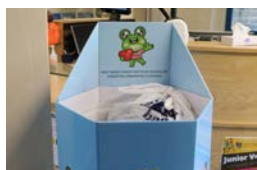
Five outstanding entries will be submitted to the official Science Week competition to be judged by members of the British Science Association.
