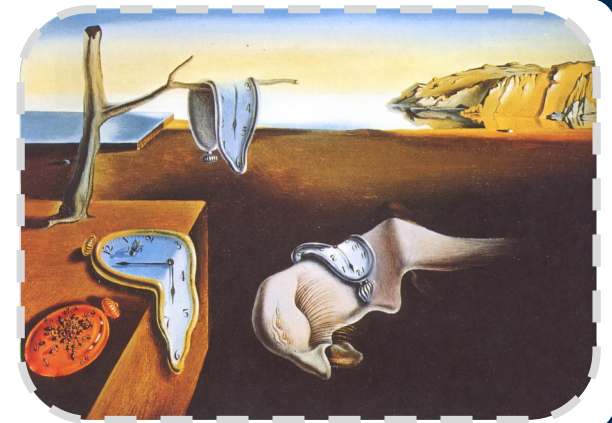
### **The Science of Sound**

In our science lessons we are learning about sound including how sounds are made and how our ears work. Design and make a musical instrument that has an interesting sound. You could also write a short explanation of how you made it as well as explaining how the sound reaches our ears.



### **Super Surrealists**

In Art and Design we will learn about 'viewpoints and dreams'. We will look at the work of surrealist artists such as Salvador Dali. Make a piece of art inspired by a dream. Or create a dream-like, mystical landscape. Make sure that you use all of your creative talents by incorporating lots of colours and textures.



### **Incredible Information**

During our Talk for Writing lessons we will write our own information texts about the imaginary rainbow dragon.
