Competition Amazing Artists

This term we will develop our sketching and drawing skills. Create a pencil drawing of something that you like. Research famous sketches from history such as Paul Rubens' 'Lion' or the 'Dancer' sketch by Edgar Degas. Your drawing should be created in pencil. If you need sketching pencils please ask your teacher.



Super Stretches

In PE we'll be exploring 'Fitness'. Create a 4 step fitness routine that we could do as a warm up at the beginning of our lessons. You can draw and write about your moves and stretches or you could take some pictures of you showing us how to do each movement.
